Upon roll call for nominations for Chair of the Knox County Commission, Commissioner Lundy nominated Commissioner Beeler. Commissioner Durrett passed. Commissioner Smith passed. Commissioner Ward passed. Commissioner Schoonmaker passed. Commissioner Busler nominated Commissioner Schoonmaker. Commissioner Beeler passed. Commissioner Dailey passed. Commissioner Jay passed.
