The Knox County Board of Commissioners met in Special Session on Thursday, September 1, 2022 at 1:30 p.m. in the Main Assembly Room of the City-County Building Main Street. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY A TWO-THIRDS (2/3) VOTE OF THE COMMISSION OF KNOX COUNTY AS FOLLOWS:

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Knox County hereby elects pursuant to T.C.A. § 8-19-101(f) to self-insure its risk of loss under the same terms, conditions and minimum limits of all official bonds otherwise required by state law for elected officials and employees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution be spread on the minutes of the Commission of Knox County, Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution, after passage and execution, shall be recorded with the Knox County Register of Deeds Office, the public welfare requiring it.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any other notifications are to be made to effectuate this Resolution, then the County Clerk is hereby requested to forward a copy of this Resolution to the proper authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution is to take effect from and after its passage, as provided by the Charter of Knox County, Tennessee, the public welfare requiring it.
