## Knox County Code Administration & Inspection Energy Conservation Code Requirements – IRC Residential

REV. 022019



Inspectors will verify energy conservation code requirements based upon 2018 IRC regulations as amended by Knox County. The owner/contractor will sign the certificate verifying the type of insulation and the equivalent R-values of the house's different insulation requirements as shown below.

<sup>\*</sup>Exception: When R-38 is required in the ceiling, R-30 shall be deemed to satisfy the requirement for R-38 wherever the full height of uncompressed R-30 insulation extends over the wall top plate at the eaves (Energy Truss). Insulation markers required every 300 sq.ft.

A permanent certificate shall be posted on or in the electrical distribution panel per Section N1101.16 of the 2018 IRC.

The building thermal envelope shall be durably sealed to limit infiltration and tested or inspected in accordance with Section N1101.12.1 of the 2018 IRC.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Exception: R-10 applies to continuous insulation, R-13 to framing cavity insulation; either insulation meets the requirement.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup> Exception: Ducts or portions thereof located completely inside the building thermal envelope.

Garage separation	Air sealing is provided between the garage and conditioned spaces.

HVAC register boots	HVAC register boots that penetrate building envelope are sealed to subfloor or drywall.
Fireplace	Fireplace walls include an air barrier.
