

# How to Mark Your Absentee Paper Ballot

1. To mark your paper ballot correctly, completely fill the box beside your choice using a **blue** or black ink **PEN**.



2. To vote for a write-in candidate, completely fill the box beside the words “write-in” and write the name of your choice on the blank line provided.
3. If you make a make too many marks in a contest or accidentally make a mark you did not intend, contact the Knox Election Commission Office to ask how to get a new one.
