If he/she does not so appear, an order will issue, requiring him/her **to appear and show cause why he/she should not be held in contempt of court (the penalty for which is indefinite incarceration)** for failure to attend the statutorily required classes. Failure to so appear will lead to an attachment by the Sheriff; an appropriate appearance bond; and a hearing as to civil contempt, with right to counsel. Civil contempt is punishable, as noted, with incarceration of indefinite duration. Court costs will of course be assessed against the non-attending parent. The clerk shall provide copies to the persons indicated above.
