Questions/Answers:

Question 1: Would Knox Count have the number of hauls on the on-call compactors from 2021-present?

Answer 1: Powell Elementary (KCS) – 30 yd compactor, averages pickup once every other week.
Rule Maintenance Facility (KCS) – 42 yard compactor is rarely used, no clear count on hauls.
World's Fair Park (PBA) – 40 yd compactor, April-November, once weekly / December-March, on call with no frequency on pickup recorded.
Volunteer Landing (PBA) – 25 yd compactor, approximately 16 hauls since July 1, 2023.

Question 2: Would Knox County have the manufacturer and model type of the vertical compactors and self-contained compactors?

Answer 2: Powell Elementary (KCS) – Manufacturer unknown
Rule Maintenance Facility (KCS) - Manufacturer unknown
City County Building (PBA) – Marathon – Side Pack TC-220-T
World's Fair Park (PBA) – Marathon – Ramjet RJ-250-SC
Volunteer Landing (PBA) – Pinnacle – SC-25
Fritts Lot (PBA) – Marathon – Vert-I-PACK

Question 3: What is the current power supply and voltage for the 4yd, 6yd, 8yd VIP & 20yd and 30yd compactor?

Answer 3: Fritts Lot (PBA) – 4 yd compactor – 230V three phase
City County Building (PBA) – 6 yd compactor – 460V three phase
Volunteer Landing (PBA) – 25 yd compactor – 460V three phase, 30 amp
World's Fair Park (PBA) – 40 yd compactor - 480V three phase
Powell Elementary (KCS) – 30 yd compactor – 268V three phase
Rule Maintenance Facility (KCS) – 42 yd compactor – 460V three phase

Question 4: Do the compactors have any special add on features for service at locations?

Answer 4: No.

Question 5: On the Knox County Government locations and Parks and Recreation locations are the 96 gal. totes stored for pickup in a serviceable location for the pickup driver? Or would the driver need to walk around properties and wheel them to the truck?

Answer 5: All of the Knox County Government locations including Parks and Recreation's 96 gallon totes are in a serviceable location.

Question 6: Would the U.S. Cellular Soccer Complex still be an active location for service with apartments being built on those grounds?

Answer 6: This is not an applicable location any longer.
