**Employee Retirement & Asset Accumulation Program  
Knox County 457(b) Fund Change  
Blackout Period  
May 15 @ 4 p.m. through May 22 @ 4 p.m.**

The Knox County Retirement & Pension Board, along with USI Consulting Group, monitors the funds under the Employee Retirement & Asset Accumulation Plan and the Knox County Voluntary 457(b) Plan. After careful consideration and upon the recommendation of USI Consulting Group, the Board has approved a change to one investment style. Please keep in mind that the fund being replaced will have similar investment objectives.

In order to convert to the new fund, the Voice Response and Internet Systems will be unavailable from 4:00 p.m. May 15, 2009 through 4:00 p.m. May 22, 2009 for the Aggressive Investment Style in the Knox County Voluntary 457(b) Plan only. You will still be able to make inquiries or changes to any fund or blend except the 457(b) Aggressive Investment Style. You will have full access to the updated system no later than Friday, May 22, 2009 after 4:00 p.m.

While the system is unavailable, your assets will continue to be invested in the investment options you have chosen as of May 15th. No investment changes or distributions will be processed during the Blackout Period from the Knox County 457(b) Aggressive Investment Style. Once the assets have been liquidated from the terminated funds, the assets will be re-invested in the new funds within 48 hours.
