Saturday Concert Series Concludes with Leftfoot Dave and Davis Mitchell

KNOXVILLE, Tenn.— The Second Saturday Concert Series wraps up this Saturday with Leftfoot Dave and the Magic Hats playing at the Cove and Davis Mitchell taking the stage at Clayton Park.

The free concerts are held from 6 to 8 p.m. June through August on the second Saturday of each month. Attendees are encouraged to bring their own blankets, lawn chairs, and food. However, no alcohol is allowed.
