Knox County to Celebrate Opening of Latest Park with River Access

WHERE: McBee Ferry Park
(1233 Old Strawberry Plains Pike off Andrew Johnson Highway, east of Mascot Road.)

BACKGROUND: Knox County Mayor Glenn Jacobs and local leaders on Thursday morning will celebrate the official opening of McBee Ferry Park, a roughly four-acre site along the upper Holston River that will feature water access.

The Legacy Parks Foundation secured the land some years back and donated it to the county. It's located on Old Strawberry Plains Pike off Andrew Johnson Highway.

Mayor Jacobs will be joined by Carol Evans, executive director of the Legacy Parks Foundation; Knox County Commissioner Richie Beeler; and Parks and Recreation Director Joe Mack.
